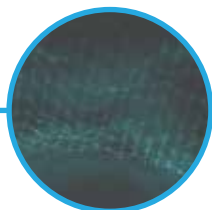

Biblical Overview

Dates: 26 Jan – 6 Apr 2026

Term 1 registration closes: 26 Jan

Lecturer: Dr Quinton Howitt

Without a clear big picture, the Bible can feel confusing and disconnected. In this course, you'll trace the one unified story from creation to new creation. You'll see how Scripture answers life's big questions—Who am I? What's wrong? What is God doing about it?—and discover how your own story fits inside God's mission, rather than standing on the sidelines.



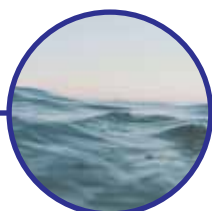
Theology of the Kingdom

Dates: 20 Apr – 29 Jun 2026

Term 2 registration closes: 20 Apr

Lecturer: Dr Derek Morpew

Jesus' central message was the Kingdom of God, yet many Christians find this vague or secondary. This course shows how the Kingdom is the key that unlocks the Bible and clarifies your purpose. You'll explore early Kingdom themes in the Old Testament, its breakthrough in the life of Jesus, and the "already/not yet" reality that shapes Christian discipleship, ministry, and hope.



Demonstrating the Kingdom

Dates: 13 Jul – 21 Sept 2026

Term 3 registration closes: 13 Jul

The Christian life is more than going to church and doing good deeds. This course helps you actively participate in God's Kingdom today. You'll grow in sharing the good news, learn to minister in the power of the Holy Spirit, and practise discerning His voice. Expect a hands-on journey into healing, deliverance, and Spirit-led encouragement that impacts your everyday relationships and ministry.



Jesus and Apprenticeship in the Gospels

Dates: 28 Sept – 7 Dec 2026

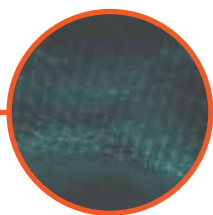
If you feel tired of trying to be a "good Christian", this course offers a different way. Anchored in Jesus' invitation, "Come to me... and I will give you rest," you'll explore what it means to be His apprentice—to live as He would, if He were you. You'll see the Kingdom and its commands as expressions of love, not legalism, and discover how real character change flows from a life rooted in deep affection for Jesus.

Faith and Reason: Introducing Christian Apologetics

Lecturer: Michael Day

Sharing your faith can feel intimidating, as if it's only for theologians or "experts". You may feel the tension between the Great Commission and your own confidence. This course reframes apologetics as a compassionate calling rather than an argument to win. Following Jesus as our model, you'll learn to listen well, respond wisely, and build a confident heart and mind rooted in biblical truth—so you can engage anyone, anywhere.



Paul and Transformation in the Epistles

Lecturer: Dr Alexander Venter

This course builds on "Jesus and Apprenticeship in the Gospels" and asks, "How does this apprenticeship grow over time?" You'll explore classic stages of spiritual growth—purification, illumination, and union—and unpack what "union with Christ" means for your daily life. You'll see how God patiently works over time to reshape your character, and how to cooperate with His transforming grace.



The Historical Jesus

Lecturer: Dr Alexander Venter

Who was the real Jesus of Nazareth? Beyond stained glass and Sunday school pictures stands a historical figure whose life changed the world. Using trusted biblical scholarship, this course explores Jesus' world, identity, and message. It's not just history—it's a fresh encounter with the Jesus who still confronts and comforts today. As Derek Morphew puts it, the way you see Jesus determines the way you see everything.



Biblical Interpretation

Lecturer: Dr Derek Morphew

Are you ready to read the Bible as one unified story that points to Jesus? If you long to move from "I want to live as a mature follower" to "I know how to apply Scripture", this course is for you. With a focus on relationship with God rather than information alone, you'll learn key skills for "correctly handling the word of truth" (2 Tim 2:15). Your Bible reading can become a living conversation with the God who speaks.
